- is an open all-day- school

- is a two-class school and is visited by around 190 children
- at the moment there work 13 female teachers and a social worker, who are supported by trainee teachers and annual interns
- the school house is newly renovated in many areas and offers a library, computer room, group rooms and one room each for the open all-day-school, additional care and social work furthermore a kitchen and a spacious entrance area



 there is an adjacent gym, a sports ground within walking distance and the swimming lessons in the teaching pool at Fröbelstrasße are reached by bus

For now we are looking forward to the completion of the new building with canteen, new spacious rooms, and the further expansion of digital school as well as the remodeling of the outdoor area.
